INTRODUCING THE INDEPENDENT INNOVATOR CHALLENGE

The Independent Innovator Challenge (IIC) is an annual competition created to offer K-12 students from all over the United States helpful feedback on their ideas, apps, or prototypes, and a chance to compete in the US National Innovator Challenge. The IIC is an online nation-wide platform where innovators can showcase their brilliant ideas, apps, and prototypes, compete, and receive recognition.

- Must be a grade K-12 (or the equivalent) student, residing in the U.S. (for teams, one member must reside in the U.S.)
- Must register as an individual, or team (up to three students), but not both
- Must have an original Innovation to submit

IDEAS

There could be a drawing, mockup, or static model showing the parts, but it does not actually work. There could also be a functional project, organization, or process plan. The solution is conceptual.



APPS

Participants have created and coded an app or software program solving a real-world problem. They have a functioning program that is capable of operation to some degree, even though it may not work perfectly.



PROTOTYPES

Participants have completed a physical invention prototype solving a real-world problem. They have a functioning model that is capable of operation to some degree, even though it may not work perfectly. It does not have to be the correct size or made of the correct materials.
